Courses marked in green is taught in language 2 (first foreign language)

The course in *Human Science* is a combination of geography and history. The course will be taught in language 2 in 3. Secondary.

The course *Integrated Science* is a combination of the subjects biology, physics and chemistry.

From 4th Secondary the course in *Integrated Science* will be subdivided into biology, chemistry and physics. *Human Science* will be subdivided into geography and history. Both history and geography will be taught in L2.

The courses in PE, Art, Music and ICT can be taught in English, French, German or Danish.

Optional courses:

In 2. Secondary students can choose *Latin* and in 3. Secondary pupils can choose between ICT and Latin. It's only possible to proceed with *Latin* if the pupil has taken the course in 2. Secondary.

In 4th the pupils must select 4-8 periods from the following subjects:

The total of lessons must be between a minimum of **31** and a **maximum of 35** periods per week for all pupils.

6th-7th: Orientation Cycle: The Baccalaireate

Compulsary courses:

L1, L2, Math (3 or 5 periods), PE

1 science course (minimum is biology for 2 periods/weeks), Philosophy (2 periods), History (2 periods), Geography (2 periods)

Minimal total of compulsory periods: 21

All 2 period-subjects can be taken as a 4 period option as well (Advanced level).

4 periods courses:

L3, L4, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Economy, Latin, Philosophy, History, Geography, Art.

All students should have between 31 and 35 lessons per week and at least two 4 period courses.
