Every year we open three new nursery classes (one in each language section).

In August 2021, we will also open a new Secondary 1 class in our French language section.

Admissions to Secondary 1 and the new nursery classes open on 24 November 2020 and close on 15 January 2021.

In the 2021/22 school year, we will also open three new Secondary 5 classes (English and Danish language section). S5 is equivalent to the first year in a Danish gymnasium. Students who successfully complete Secondary 5 to Secondary 7 (Upper Secondary) are awarded the European Baccalaureate Diploma, which is an officially recognised entry qualification for higher education in the European Union as well as many other countries. **Visitor days and an information evening will be held in January 2021.
